

CV Milan Cizman

Milan Čižman graduated in 1966 at Medical School Ljubljana and received Board certificate in Pediatrics and in Infectious Diseases and epidemiology in 1973 and 1986 respectively. He was employed in University Medical Centre , Department of Infectious Diseases from 1968 until 2013, when he was retired. Since 1980 he was involved in teaching in Medical School Ljubljana. His research predominately focused in epidemiology of different bacteria, consumption of antimicrobials and the correlations between antibiotic use and resistance and influence of interventions on use of antimicrobials and participated in many EU projects. He was member of many international and national societies and the reviewer of many scientific journals. For his contributions in European Society of Pediatric Infectious Diseases (ESPID) he got Bill Marshall award and the Matajč recognition from Slovenian Society of Pediatrics. He published over 400 scientific papers in national and international journals and proceedings of scientific meetings. In last twenty years he was involved in writing recommendations for prescribing of antimicrobials in the community and hospitals.
